Delhi International Airport (DIAL) strives to make Delhi Airport a “Climate Resilient Airport” by implementing climate change mitigation and adaptation measures as part of our business strategy. This Climate Resilience Program is derived from DIAL's Environment and Sustainability Policy, published in 2022 and outlines the commitment and actions as given below:

DIAL's will strive to:

- Implement and maintain Greenhouse Gas (GHG) management system in line with globally recognized standards to achieve the targets.
- Assess and address climate change risk and opportunities periodically.
- Apply GHG emission reductions measures such as energy efficiency and energy conservation, renewable energy, green building concepts, green transportation program, operational efficiency, competency development together with Airport stakeholders.
- Collaborate with Airport stakeholders to reduce the Scope 3 GHG emission from their activities and facilitate the use of Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) at the Airport.
- Achieve the target of “Net Zero Carbon Emission Airport” by 2030 by reducing absolute GHG emissions (Scope 1 & 2) of Airport in line globally recognized programs.
- Adopt climate resilience actions at the Airport taking account of climate change risk & opportunities, innovation & technology, national & global commitments and requirements.
- Communicate and promote climate resilience actions needed with Airport stakeholders.
